### Year Six's learning this half term:

## **English:**

This term, Year Six will be continuing to focus on the theme of Identity and Diversity and how this can impact the lives of different people. They will explore the theme through their core text for this term,

Stella by Starlight by Sharon. M. Draper. This book explores life during segregation in America. The text will help the children to explore the difficulties of coping in a world where choices were unfair.

Linked to this, the class will work together on a writing outcome, of which will be a non-linear narrative where they are able to show a variety of writing skills, including the use of sentence structure for variety and a range of vocabulary for impact and effect.

**Maths:** Maths lessons this term will focus on the children developing their understanding of how to apply skills they have learned this year. They will continue to develop their understanding of arithmetic using technology and practise mathematical reasoning in the form of word problems. They will complete a variety of investigations linked to different real life scenarios and will enjoy a final enterprise project in the last part of the year.











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
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# Year 6's learning this term:

**Art:** In art lessons, the children will be creating text and image pictures based on the work of Sam Cannon. This will be linked to their core text and curriculum work.

**Science:** This half term the children will focus on the topic animals including humans. They will consider how the heart works, how blood travels around the body and the effect exercise has on us.

**PE:** This half term, the children will be enjoying team-building games in preparation for the sports day in July.



### **General Information**

PE: PE will take place once a week. Please make sure children bring their PE kits in every Monday. They will be taken home again each Friday so they can be washed. It is important the children have their PE kit in school every day. They should have suitable clothing and footwear for both indoor and outdoor PE.
