RE: Teacher Industrial Action-Tuesday 2nd May

Thank you for your patience in awaiting an update following our previous communication about the planned industrial action for teachers announced to take place in London and the South East on **Tuesday 2nd May.** 

## This letter is to inform you about arrangements for the next strike day <u>only</u>, which is next Tuesday 2nd May.

It is important to acknowledge that the planned industrial action is not aimed at parents or school leaders but rather, central government decision making. Our teachers work incredibly hard for the children and families of our school community and this is not an action that they have taken lightly.

We can now confirm that due to strike action and lack of staffing which classes <u>will be closed</u> on **Tuesday 2nd May.** Your child's attendance will not be affected by the strike day as they will be coded as a Y (unable to attend due to exceptional circumstances.)
