Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: Teacher Industrial Action- **Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July**

Thank you for your patience in awaiting an update following our previous communication about the planned industrial action for teachers announced to take place across England on **Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July**.

**This letter is to inform you about arrangements for the next strike days which are next Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July.**

It is important to acknowledge that the planned industrial action is not aimed at parents or school leaders but rather, central government decision making. Our teachers work incredibly hard for the children and families of our school community and this is not an action that they have taken lightly.

We can now confirm that due to strike action and lack of staffing which classes **will be closed** on **Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July**. Your child's attendance will not be affected by the strike day as they will be coded as a Y (unable to attend due to exceptional circumstances.)
