### RE: School Clubs

We are pleased to offer the following after school clubs during the Summer Term (Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September– Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023).

Following valuable parental feedback to expand our extracurricular activities, we have organised for outside specialists to come into school and offer some new and exciting clubs for the children to join. We have subsidised the costs for these clubs to make them more affordable for you. However, we are confident that the modest price will not deter you from booking these compelling activities.

To ensure that we maximise attendance at all clubs, for this term we will charge £12 per block (less than £2 per session.) If you have any questions about this, please speak to a member of the office staff or Leadership team.

All after school clubs will be open for live bookings on **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July from 13.00**. We urge you to check you know your Arbor login details before this and will close once all spaces have been allocated via Arbor.

If we feel that a child's behaviour is persistently impacting on the learning and enjoyment of other children in the group, parents will be informed and there is the possibility that the child could lose their place in the club. Refunds will not always be provided in this instance - it will be dependent on the number of children on the waiting list.
