Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well. We are writing to inform you about a deeply concerning incident that occurred within our local community yesterday afternoon.

It has come to our attention that a teenager was involved in a serious incident resulting in a fatality. This tragic event has understandably left many in our community feeling unsettled and concerned about safety. While this incident did not occur within the grounds of a school, we understand that it may affect pupils, staff, and families in various ways.

As a school, we are committed to fostering a safe and supportive environment for all children. We want to assure you that we are taking appropriate measures to support our community. Greenwich Council and the Metropolitan Police are working together to increase their police presence in the community, which means you can expect to see an enhanced police presence around the scene and the surrounding area.

We would urge anyone who witnessed this horrific incident or has any information which might help, to call police on 101 quoting reference 3795/07JAN25 or call Crimestoppers anonymously.

Today, KS2 pupils took part in an assembly on community safety and were given practical advice on how to keep themselves safe in the local area, especially if they travel to and from school alone. We also are in contact with our local police schools team, who will be coming into school later in the spring term to hold an assembly and various workshops with children on how to ensure they are safe outside of school.
